

Parkview Creative Arts Scholarship Fund

Parkview Baptist Church has established the **Parkview Creative Arts Scholarship Fund** to encourage the spiritual and professional development of future church music ministry leaders. Guidelines for the management and reporting of the progress of this fund are outlined below:

Guidelines:

To be considered for this scholarship a student must:

- Maintain a minimum 2.5 GPA.
- Be a member in good standing of a local body of Christian believers.
- Be enrolled as a student in the Parkview Fine Arts Academy.
- Submit an application to the Scholarship Committee by the stated deadline.
- Be recommended by their creative arts teacher and the Scholarship Committee.

Fund Management Guidelines:

- Contributions to the Parkview Creative Arts Scholarship Fund will be administered solely by Parkview Baptist Church.
- The amount awarded to each recipient is not to exceed $\frac{3}{4}$ of tuition for any given period of study nor be less than $\frac{1}{4}$ for the same period of study.
- Earnings will be re-invested to allow this scholarship fund to grow.
- Granting of a scholarship award in any given period neither implies nor guarantees future awards.
- All awards will go directly toward tuition in the **Parkview Fine Arts Academy** for continued study.
- All scholarship awards will be approved by the Scholarship Committee.
- The Scholarship Committee will consist of the following people:
 - Senior Pastor
 - Business Administrator
 - Sanctuary Choir Officers
 - Director of Fine Arts Academy
 - Associate Pastor of Worship & Creative Arts
