We have been closely monitoring the updates from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, [CDC](#), local officials, and medical professionals. Members of the staff and Trustees have gathered to formulate a strategy for the near future. We have prayed about how to implement a new plan so that we can limit your exposure to the virus and protect your health. We also would like to ensure that each of you has an opportunity to worship. We know that this plan may not fit or suit everyone's needs but be assured that we have been diligent to seek out the best path to follow during these uncertain times. This plan is by no means set in concrete and may need to be adjusted based upon the updates we receive and regulations that we must follow.

Many of you may be concerned about the upcoming activities this weekend with the new Pastoral Candidate, Chris DeGeorge, coming In View of a Call. Unfortunately, in the light of the events, we will be canceling the Meet and Greet with Chris and his family on Saturday. Instead, we will be airing a live Panel Discussion online on our website at [pbcbr.org](#) at 2:00 PM. We ask your assistance to submit questions that we can ask Chris and have him answer during this time. Chris will preach at 8:30 AM Sunday. We understand that many of you cannot attend. We encourage you to stay home if you are in any of the susceptible categories set by the CDC. For those who are unable to attend we encourage you to watch the service live on our website [Here](#).

We will proceed with voting on Sunday. While this is not ideal, we have constructed two ways for you to cast your ballot. First, you will be to attend the 8:30 AM service and vote. Secondly, for those who do not attend the service but choose to vote, the Trustees will be stationed under the Porte Coche at the main entrance with ballots that you can vote and turn in without leaving your vehicle. This Voting Drive-Up Station will be open from 8:30 – 11:00 AM. Be aware that all voting will be halted at 11:00 AM.

Please be assured that we have prayerfully considered all options. We ask for you to be open to what we are doing as a church.
